



Sonic to Broadcast Year-End 2007 Conference Call Live on the Internet

OKLAHOMA CITY, Oct 02, 2007 /PRNewswire-FirstCall via COMTEX News Network/ -- Sonic Corp. (Nasdaq: SONC), the nation's largest chain of drive-in restaurants, today announced that it will provide an online Web simulcast of its year-end fiscal 2007 earnings release conference call on Tuesday, October 16, 2007. During that call, management will comment on Sonic's financial and operational results for the fourth quarter and fiscal year ended August 31, 2007, which will be released following the market's close on October 15, 2007, and review the company's outlook for the first quarter of fiscal 2008.
