## SONIC TO BROADCAST ITS YEAR-END 2004 CONFERENCE CALL LIVE ON THE INTERNET

OKLAHOMA CITY (September 29, 2004) – Sonic Corp. (NASDAQ/NM:SONC) today announced that it will provide an online Web simulcast of its year-end fiscal 2004 earnings release conference call on Wednesday, October 13, 2004. During that call, management will comment on Sonic's financial and operational results for the fourth quarter and fiscal year ended August 31, 2004, which will be released following the market's close on October 12, 2004, and review the company's earnings guidance for the first quarter of fiscal 2005.

The live broadcast of Sonic's conference call will begin at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time on October 13, 2004. An online replay will be available approximately two hours following the conclusion of the live broadcast and will continue through November 13, 2004.
