SONIC TO BROADCAST ITS FIRST QUARTER 2006 CONFERENCE CALL LIVE ON THE INTERNET

OKLAHOMA CITY (December 21, 2005) – Sonic Corp. (NASDAQ/NM:SONC), the nation's largest chain of drive-in restaurants, today announced that it will provide an online Web simulcast of its first quarter fiscal 2006 earnings release conference call on Thursday, January 5, 2006. During that call, management will comment on Sonic's financial and operational results for the first quarter ended November 30, 2005, which will be released following the market's close on January 4, 2006, and review the company's earnings guidance for the second quarter of fiscal 2006.

The live broadcast of Sonic's conference call will begin at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time on January 5, 2006. An online replay will be available approximately two hours following the conclusion of the live broadcast and will continue through February 5, 2006.
